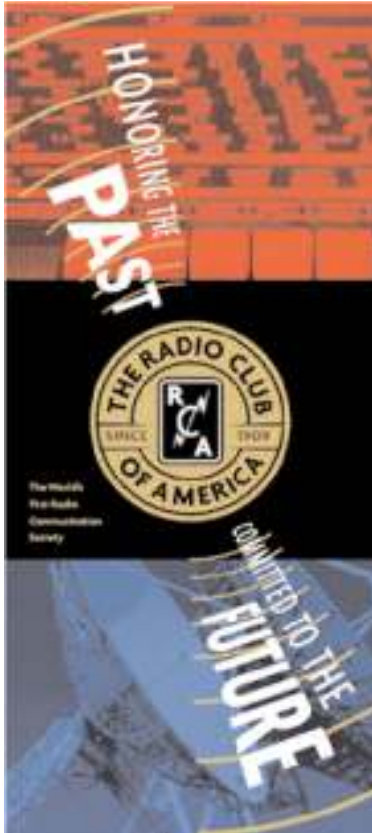

A pioneer in the personal communications industry and is an innovator in spectrum management. Martin conceived the first portable cellular radiophone in 1973, called the father of portable cellular telephony. ArrayComm, LLC is the world's leader in MAS, Multi-antenna Signal Processing, also known as smart antenna technology. As VP & Corporate Director of Research & Development at Motorola, he was responsible for the creation & stimulation of technology. Martin founded Cellular Business Systems, Inc. Martin received the RCA's *Fred M. Link Award* in 1996 and the American Computer Museum's George R. Stibitz Computer and Communications Pioneer Award in 2002, he was an inaugural member of RCR's Wireless Hall of Fame, Red Herring magazine named him one of the Top 10 Entrepreneurs of 2000, and Wireless Systems Design provided him with the 2002 Industry Leader award.
