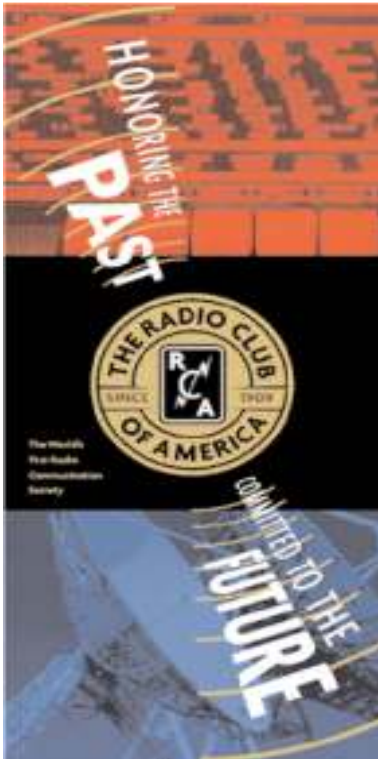

Visit to the Smithsonian Friday, Nov. 20, 2-5 p.m.
